

## Maths

**Circles** – Practise counting up and down in 2s up to 20, 3s up to 30 and 5s up to 50. Go outside and find sticks/stones/make snowballs/etc to help you.

**Squares** – We are going to practise the 3, 4, 6, and 8 times tables. Go outside and find sticks/stones/make snowballs/etc to make groups to help you with your times tables.

For example,

$$3 \times 1 = 3$$

3 sticks in 1 group. 3 sticks altogether.

$$3 \times 2 = 6$$

3 sticks in 2 groups. 6 sticks altogether.

$$3 \times 3 = 9$$

3 sticks in 3 groups. 9 sticks altogether.

Continue up to  $3 \times 10 =$

Practise the 3 and 6 times table - do you see a pattern?

Now practise the 4 times table and the 8 times table - do you see a pattern?

**Triangles** – We have been learning to use the jump strategy to add numbers up to 1,000. Today, I would like you to practise adding numbers up to 10,000. Use the jump strategy to find the answers to the following questions:

1.  $2,700 + 1,500 =$  \_\_\_\_
2.  $3,850 + 3,670 =$  \_\_\_\_
3.  $6,462 + 2,580 =$  \_\_\_\_
4.  $4,321 + 5,432 =$  \_\_\_\_
5.  $3,752 + 4,493 =$  \_\_\_\_

Primary 3 – Find a picture of your favourite dinosaur on the internet. Have a go at drawing your dinosaur and write the name of it underneath.

Include the following information on your factfile: picture and name of dinosaur, when it lived on Earth, its height, weight, length, diet and an interesting fact.
