Literacy

We will be learning about ice melting and evaporation so go out and get some snow/ice in a container and watch it melt indoors. Look at the clock when you take it in – how many minutes did it take to melt?

Set up a little evaporation experiment - 3 little dishes/tubs with the same amount of water in each. Put one in a warm place, one in a cold place and one in a medium temperature and observe over the next day or two.

Questions:

- What do you **predict** (think) will happen?
- Which tub will **evaporate** first?

Evaporation – when liquid is heated up and turns into a gas.

Predict – saying what you think will happen in the future because of something.

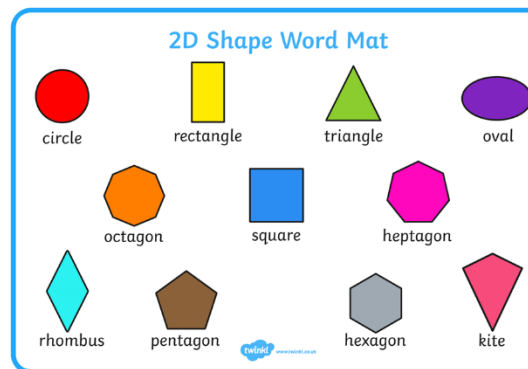
Nessy – Those who do Nessy in school can log in and practise for 15 minutes today.

- ✓ The names of 2D shapes.
- ✓ Describing 2D shapes using the terms side and vertices (corners).

- Can the circles maths group draw lines where the diagonals are? (A diagonal is a straight line going from corner to corner inside the shape.)
