IDL - Interdisciplinary Learning

IDL

Our topic is *Animals*.

The key areas we will learn about are:

- Learning how to identify different living things and explore how their features help them survive.
- Researching how animals communicate and discover how sound travels in waves through air, water, and other materials.
- Investigating how plants and animals depend on each other in ecosystems and how we can help, design or care for a wildlife area.

Our other topic is *Chemical Reactions*.

- We will collaborate in activities that safely demonstrate simple chemical reactions using everyday materials. We will begin to understand that a chemical reaction is a change that creates new materials.

This or That

We will continue to explore topics such as *Burns Night*, *Up Helly Aa*, *Random Acts of Kindness Day*, *International Day of Women and Girls in Science* and other themed learning opportunities.

Literacy

Reading: Individualised reading groups and programme. Novel reading for some groups.

Writing: Throughout our writing we will use elements of our writing programme alongside focus on non-chronological reports, poetry and more.

Spelling: Daily wraparound spelling (individual group).

Handwriting: Progression with joins.

Grammar/Punctuation: Using speech marks.

Library: Our weekly library slot is on **Friday**. This time is dedicated to reading for pleasure and borrowing a book to take home.


