IDL

Our main topic is *Our Area*.

The key areas we will learn about are:

- I can describe how Scotland's landscapes were formed, explain natural disasters and their impacts, discuss how human activity affects the environment, evaluate land use developments and their effects on communities, and suggest ways to live more sustainably.

Our mini topic is *Water*.

The key areas we will learn about are:

- I can explain the water cycle and changes of state, apply my understanding of buoyancy, investigate and clean water while understanding its properties and uses, describe how substances change, separate mixtures, and explore factors that affect dissolving.

Our topic of *Chemical Reactions* will now take place this term as the secondary science teachers have kindly agreed to support our class.

This or That

We will continue to explore world topics such as *National Sourdough Bread day, World Laughter Day, International Nurses Day, Fairtrade Fortnite* and more in our 'This Section'. The students in P6/7 also selected their own choices for the 'That Section' such as emotions, mechanics, singers and more.
