

## Primary 1 and 2 Home Learning Grid: 18th January 2021

HELP AT HOME	LEARN YOUR NUMBER BONDS!	PRACTISE WRITING YOUR NAME.
Every day this week, help someone in your house to do something. It might be tidying up, doing the washing, making your tea, you decide! Try to think of ways you can help others and the importance of being kind to each other.  Draw a picture that shows kindness. P2: write about what is happening in your picture.	Practise and learn your number bonds; P1 1 up to 5 P2 1 up to 10 and learn them. Number bonds are addition sums or stories for each number e.g; 1+1=2, 2+0 = 2 3+2=5, 4+1=5, 1+4=5, 2+3=5, 5+0=5 and so on. Do this for each of the numbers in your range. You can ask an adult to write out your sums for you or P2 you can write out your own, you can play a game on Topmarks or use counters to lay out the sums. Get an adult to test you on your number bonds.	P1; Practise writing your name in your book. Concentrate on forming your letters neatly and getting them the right way around. Remember to use a capital letter at the start.  P2; Practise writing your first name and surname in your book. Concentrate on using a capital letter at the beginning of each part of your name and lower case letters for the rest. Making sure your sizes are correct and each letter is the right way around.  All; make sure your pencil grip is right. Try with a pen or different colours.
Ask an adult to help you freeze some items in individual pots.  See how long it takes to freeze and write/draw in your book.  You are going to try an experiment to see how you can rescue your toys! (water, smashing, lay in the sun and so on)  Try different ideas for each of your pots except one, this will be your test pot.  Leave your test pot alone and see how long it takes to defrost.  Draw the most effective method you used and write about what worked well or didn't!  Note down how long it took for your test post to defrost on its own.	OUTDOOR TREASURE HUNT AND ARTWORK  Can you find 20 different things outside?  Order them in length from smallest to largest Order them in weight from lightest to heaviest Can you sort them in colours?  Make some art using your treasure. Take a photo and email it to me for our blog.	BOARD GAMES!  Play some board games with your family.  Take turns appropriately and be a good sport.  Try to play a different game every day!  Which was your favourite?  Which did you least enjoy?
