Here are some activities that we would have done in class; Choose 2 to complete</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make a haggis, neeps and tatties collage on a paper plate or circle of paper. • Look at the PPT and learn about Robert Burns • Make your own Tartan using any media you like; wool, paper, paint, crayons etc. • If possible, try making a traditional Burns Supper (at home) and recite Selkirk Grace. 	<p>Coding Ask an adult to download the free app ScratchJr onto a device.  You can access it here https://www.scratchjr.org/ If you click on the question mark on the app, you will get an introduction to using the app. Pay attention, as it can be tricky. Now have some fun! Play around and see if you can get your cat to move. Add another character and see if you can create a moving story. Change the colour of your background and your cat. Put a piece of treasure on the floor. You are going to practice coding a person. Ask a person to close their eyes and give them instructions to move; forward, turn left, turn right or backwards. Guide your person to the treasure. (It is trickier than it sounds!)</p>	<p>Relax! Wednesday is a school holiday. (usually after Up Helly Aa) Spend the day relaxing and enjoying time with your family.</p>
