



Henri-Matisse



This week you will be creating a drawing/painting in the style of Henri Matisse!

The type of art work you will be creating is called a STILL LIFE.

A STILL LIFE is a collection of objects put together by the artist.



Collect up to 7 objects from around your house. Place them together on a tea towel or fabric.

Think about the colours and sizes of the objects.



Lightly draw out your Still Life .

Carefully look at the shapes.

When you are ready and happy with your drawing — get the colour in!!

Try not to scribble and TAKE YOUR TIME!



Lightly sketch out your still life.

Always looking at the shapes.

Think about the background. Will it be patterned or will it be plain?

What is going to be right at the front of your artwork?

Remember to fill the whole sheet of paper!

Keep looking at Matisse for inspiration!!



Slowly add in colour and pattern

You should use whatever you have.

If you don't have any paint you could even use cut paper ((be careful though!!))



Matisse did not like big empty spaces in his Still Life.

So be sure to add lots of colour and pattern!!
