## Primary 2A 2023-2024

### English

- **Reading** - We will be working on developing questions on the books we have read. Focusing on who, what, where and when. We will use prediction at various points in the story. Where appropriate, the pupils will be encouraged to link to personal experiences.
- **Writing** - We will look at using a variety of different openers in our writing. We will continue to build our sentences using nouns, verbs and adjectives in our writing. We will begin to use laptops to type up our writing.
- **Listening and talking** - We will be using sequencing language to describe what we are doing. We will share our news in class weekly and get a chance to ask others questions on their news.
- **Handwriting** - Continue with correct formation and heights.
- **Spelling** - We will be learning a new spelling pattern/sound each week. We will also be revising the p2 silver common words.

### Science, Social Studies, RME and ICT

- Learn to distinguish between living and non-living things.
- Sort living things into groups.
- Explore basic food chains.
- Investigate what plants need in order to grow.
- Learn about keeping safe near the sea.
- Book study of The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch.
- Our school value focus this term is Inclusion and Happiness.
- Our RME focus will be the bible stories Noah's Ark and Jonah and the Whale.
- For ICT we will look at opening, closing and saving a file.

### Physical Education

This term we will continue swimming as well as athletics, striking and fielding activities and games. We will also be doing outdoor learning weekly.

### Mathematics

- We will be introducing multiplication and division.
- We will be learning about money.
- We will look at information handling including gathering, sorting and presenting data.
- We will learn about chance and uncertainty.
- We will look at some of the different ways in which maths has influenced our lives.

### Language- French

- We will continue with French greetings.
- We will recap numbers and colours in French.
- We will learn the days of the week.

### Art

We will be doing craft activities related to our topic. We will look at collage techniques in art lessons.

### Music

We will continue to develop our knowledge and understanding of pulse, rhythm & pitch through rhymes, action games and singing games. We will improvise pulse actions for a range of songs and rhymes and reinforce our understanding of the differences between pulse and rhythm, rhyme and song. We will focus on showing the shape of a melody with hand and body movements and we will also learn the solfa names and hand-signs for *so* and *mi*.
