Primary 3a

Literacy

- Continue to learn new spelling patterns, common words and tricky words.
- Revise letter formation and write consistently using the correct heights.
- Be able to identify nouns and adjectives.
- Use adjectives consistently in our writing.
- Develop our comprehension skills.
- Continue to develop our fluency when reading aloud, concentrating on using the correct pace of reading.
- Learn about what skills are important during group discussion.

Physical Education

 In PE, the class will be doing gymnastics with a focus on improving core stability and strength as well as building confidence and self-esteem.
