

Term 1 Curriculum Overview

Primary 2A

English

- Reading - We will be working on becoming familiar with reading aloud in a group again and improving our reading fluency.
- We will be reading well known fairy tales in class.
- Writing - We will be learning to write using finger spaces, capital letters and full stops.
- Listening and talking - We will be revising the sounds. We will use puppets to re-tell familiar fairy tales. We will develop our skills in talking in front of others by sharing our news with the class.
- Handwriting - We will be ensuring our lower case letter formations are all correct.

Science, Social Studies and ICT

- We will make up our class charter together as a class, deciding on what is important to make our class a lovely place to be.
- We will be recording and sharing our learning by taking photographs and uploading them to our class blog.
- In Health and Wellbeing we will focus on our feelings and wellbeing. Our school value this term is happiness.
- RME will focus on the bible story of Noah's Ark.
- Our topic this term is Fairy Tales.

Physical Education

This term we will focus on our creativity through movement skills, and using small apparatus to develop our capabilities in respect and tolerance.

Mathematics

- We will be revising our number knowledge through counting, sequencing and patterns.
- We will investigate 2D and 3D shapes in our environment and learn some vocabulary associated with them.
- We will practise our number formation and use this in our daily maths work.
- We will be learning to recognise the number names in written form.

Language- French Revision

- Begin to reply with intonation.

Art

Focus on drawing and collage skills through creating artwork related to our topic.

Music
