

Term 2 Curriculum Overview

Primary 2A

P2 will be doing a Christmas performance on Thursday 8th December.

English

- We will be focusing on rhyme this term.
- **Reading** – We will be recognising punctuation, learning about its importance and working on using the punctuation in stories to help us read with fluency.
- **Writing** – We will continue to focus on using punctuation in our writing. We will use new vocabulary in our writing specific to our topic.
- **Listening and talking** – We will be talking in front of an audience as part of our Christmas performance. We will learn about using our body language on stage.
- **Handwriting** – Continue to ensure we have correct letter formation and begin to look at the heights of the letters.
- **Spelling** – We will break the word down into individual sounds and use the letters that represent the sounds to build the word.
- Our class novel this term is 'The Owl who is Afraid of the Dark'.

Science, Social Studies and ICT

- We will be looking at the Zones of Regulation in more detail with a series of lessons linked to this.
- We look at how to assess and manage risk to keep ourselves safe.
- Our school value this term is safety.
- For RME we will focus on the Christmas story.
- Our topic this term is Night and Day. This will include investigating energy used for light and electrical circuits.

Physical Education

This term we will be doing gymnastics with a focus on multi-processing and decision-making.

Mathematics

- We will be developing our understanding of number by learning about place value.
- We will continue to look at number order including introduction to greater than and less than.
- We will be learning to follow and make directions with our bodies and electronic maths toys, using the associated directional vocabulary

Language- French Revision

- Learn the numbers to 20 and use them in simple games such as bingo.
- Learn the days of the week
- Learn the months of the year

Art

Focus on drawing and collage skills through creating artwork related to our topic and Christmas.

Music

- Musical activities relating to our topic and our Christmas performance.

Homework

- **Spelling:** Spelling homework to consolidate patterns/rules taught in class.
- **Reading:** Practise reading aloud to an adult. Show your understanding by answering and asking questions on the story and discussing the plot.
- **Numeracy:** Simple maths activities to reinforce concepts taught in class.
