Primary 2A 2022-2023

English

- Reading We will be reading a selection of non-fiction texts. We will learn about sequencing into what is happening in the beginning, middle and end. We will use nonfiction books to learn more about famous people. We will do shared reading with primary 6b pupils. There will also be activities planned for World Book Day.
- Writing We will begin to include nouns and verbs in our writing. We will begin to use note taking as a skill when writing.
- Listening and talking -We will be working on improving listening skills. We will do a talk on our favourite famous person.
- Handwriting Our focus is correct letter formation, correct heights and ensuring we write on the line with finger spaces.
- **Spelling** We will continue with learning a new spelling pattern/sound each week.

Science, Social Studies, RME and ICT

- We will continue to learn about the Zones of Regulation in more depth.
- Our topic this term is Famous People. We will learn about a variety of different people and what they are famous for.
