- Continue to revise upper and lower case letter formation.
- Learn to use different types of punctuation.
- Develop skills in extending writing through using conjunctions and a variety of sentence openers.
- Develop our comprehension skills.
- Compare fiction and non-fiction books.
- Introduce show and tell/news time.

Physical Education

- Develop cue recognition through dance.
- Develop responsibility and leadership through playing games.
- Develop co-ordination and stamina through skipping.

- Learn about texture and how we can create it in different ways then use it in our artwork.
