Literacy	Do some research and create a fact file about a Viking god or goddess. You can use the internet or look at any books that you might have.	Write a Viking saga. Remember to describe your characters, add adjectives to describe where you are going and what you are doing. Remember to check your work for full stops and capital letters as you go.
Numeracy	<p>Can you solve the following problem:</p> <p>I bought 135 metres of red fabric and 60 metres of white fabric to make a Viking sail. I have used 18 metres of the red fabric and 20 metres of white fabric. How many metres of fabric do I have left in total?</p> <p>Can you make up some more Viking maths questions?</p>	Can you make a Viking longship or a longhouse? Write down what shapes you used to make it.
Other	Use the internet to investigate places that the Vikings came from / went (their homelands and settlements). You could create a poster or a PowerPoint to show your findings.	Design a Viking-themed board game. Can you make a list of the rules? Get somebody to play it with you. Would you change anything?
	Write a food diary for 2 days. Highlight foods you think would have been available for the Vikings.	Design a piece of Viking jewellery. What materials would be used to make this? What colours would it be?
