


<p><b>Maths Online – recognising coins</b></p> <p>Visit the website:  <a href="http://www.topmarks.co.uk/money/coins-game">www.topmarks.co.uk/money/coins-game</a>  <a href="http://www.topmarks.co.uk/money/coins-game">Coins Game for 4-10 year olds (topmarks.co.uk)</a></p> <p>Set the online game to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• British flag</li> <li>• Sort 2 coins</li> </ul> <p>When you have had a practise of this you can move on to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sort 2 coins</li> <li>• Ordering</li> <li>• Counting</li> </ul> <p>You can choose how difficult your games are – can you challenge yourself to count up 6 coins?</p> <p>Are there any coins in your house?            If there are then ask an adult if you can spend some time looking at them – you could make crayon rubbings of the two sides of the coins.</p> 	<p>Last term we did some work on alphabetical order – can you make an alphabet?</p> <p>You can make the alphabet in any way you choose. There are some ideas below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut out letters from magazines or newspapers to make the alphabet.</li> <li>• Write the letters out in the snow with a stick.</li> <li>• Write the alphabet using different colours of pens, pencils and crayons.</li> <li>• Write out the alphabet and add a picture to each letter for example an apple for A or a football for F.</li> </ul> <p>There is also an alphabetical order game online if you would like to play that. You need to order the words in alphabetical order.
