English

- Spelling Learn new spelling patterns using a variety of strategies.
- Grammar Practise alphabetical order and introduce vowels and consonants.
- Handwriting Revise upper and lower case letter formation.
- Writing Develop our understanding of conjunctions. Reinforce the importance of capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.
- Reading Continue to develop our fluency when reading aloud and be able to discuss story plot, character and setting.
- Listening and Talking Listen carefully to information and instructions. Revision of sounds.
