English

- Spelling Learn new spelling patterns using a variety of strategies.
- Grammar Practise alphabetical order and introduce vowels and consonants.
- Handwriting Revise upper and lower case letter formation and learn to say alphabet using letter names.
- Writing Use openers and continue to develop our understanding of conjunctions. Reinforce the importance of capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.
- Reading Continue to develop our fluency and expression when reading aloud and be able to discuss story plot, character and setting.
