Inclusion and Safety

Literacy

- Spelling - Practise familiar spelling patterns and learn new patterns using a variety of strategies.
- Continue to revise letter formation and write on the line consistently using the correct heights.
- Be able to identify and use nouns, proper nouns, verbs and adjectives, parsing simple sentences.
- Use adjectives consistently in writing.
- Develop comprehension skills through questioning and discussion.
- Reading for meaning - continue to develop our fluency when reading aloud, concentrating on understanding and context.

Physical Education

- In PE, the class will be doing gymnastics with a focus on core stability and strength.
- Swimming will be starting on Friday 31st October and the last session will be Friday 5th December.

- Discover where the Vikings came from.
- Investigate Vikings travels, raids and trade.
- Complete simple mapping activities.
