Make some predictions about what you think the weather might be for tomorrow and give warnings to those who need it. - Use words like: icy, swirling, freezing, sparkling, crunchy, storm, windy, north. - Make a "broadcast" to a pretend camera or family member. 	<p>Hot Chocolate Measuring Station</p> <p>Using hot chocolate powder, cups, spoons, and milk or water:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Estimate and measure "ingredients" - Compare full/empty, heavy/light - Count scoops - Add some marshmallows, squirty cream and sprinkles. <p>A brilliant hands-on volume and capacity activity which you can enjoy with your family!</p> 	<p>Melting Race Experiment</p>  <p>Bring in some handfuls of snow from outside and place in small bowls. Place one in each:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A warm room - A cold room - Near a window - Leave one outside <p>Predict which melts first and why. Tell someone what you found out in your experiment.</p>
