<p>Top secret snow mission</p> <p>You have received a top-secret snow mission.</p> <p>Mission choices (pick one):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The snow has magical powers. A snow creature needs help. School is closed... but something strange happens! <p>Fun tasks:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Write a short story (or comic strip!) showing how the mission is completed. <p>Include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ One exciting problem ★ One surprise ★ One happy ending <p>Add speech bubbles and sound words like CRUNCH! or WHOOSH!</p> <p>Extra fun:</p> <p>Read your story aloud in a "storytelling voice."</p>	<p>Snow closure shop</p> <p>The snow has closed the shops, so you're opening your own home shop!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Chooses 5-8 items to "sell" Prices them (e.g. 5p, 10p, 20p, £1) Makes simple price labels <p>Challenges:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> "I want to buy 2 items. How much altogether?" "I have 50p. What can I buy?" "Can you make exactly 30p?" <p>Write quick challenges on paper:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> "Buy 3 items for less than 40p" "Spend exactly 25p" "What's the most you can buy with 60p?" 	<p>Footprints in the snow</p>  <p>Big question: What makes the deepest footprint?</p> <p>Make your predictions then head outside and give them a go. See what makes the deepest footprint and record your findings.</p> <p>Here are some ideas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Bare feet or wellies? Jumping or standing? One foot vs two feet? Shoes or socks? Tiptoes or flat feet
