Determination and Respect

Literacy

- Spelling - Practise familiar spelling patterns and learn new patterns using a variety of strategies.
- Continue to revise letter formation and write on the line consistently using the correct heights.
- Further develop use of nouns, proper nouns, verb tenses and adjectives and parsing simple sentences.
- Continue to develop interesting vocabulary to engage reader by using adjectives consistently in writing.
- Differentiated use of varied punctuation in the writing project.
- Develop written comprehension skills.
- Reading for meaning - discussion around flow, intonation and fluency when reading aloud, concentrating on questioning for understanding.

Physical Education

In PE this term, the focus will be on

- Dance with Motivation
- Handball with Decision Making
- Badminton with Balance and Control

Art

In Art we are learning about the process of design. We will be researching headwear and using sketching to generate 3 different ideas for a piece of headwear which we will then construct

Other Curricular Areas

Our topic is Healthy Bodies.

- Learn about the skeleton, major organs and their function.
- Develop practical activities around the senses
- Become aware of how cleanliness, hygiene and safety can affect health and wellbeing.
- Discuss a range of foods and how they contribute to a healthy body.
- Develop healthy attitudes towards food and listening to our bodies.
- Learn the correct names for the parts of the body.
- Practical experiments to show the importance of physical activity and its effect on the body.
- Investigate how we can look after our bodies and who might help us with this.
- Learning about respecting personal space and boundaries.
- Learn about medicines, how they affect us and how to use them safely.
- Developing further ability to capture and share images using ICT and continue to share learning on how to open, save and close files.
- Continue to exercise the importance of online safety.
