Primary 3/4

English

Reading - develop fluency and accuracy when reading aloud and focus on reading for enjoyment.

Writing - revise basic punctuation and extend personal writing. Retell events in the correct order using greater detail.

Phonics and Spelling - learn new spelling patterns using a variety of strategies.

Handwriting - introduce the letter joins and reinforce correct letter formation.

Grammar - revise basic sentence punctuation.

Listening and talking will be embedded through topic work.

Physical Education

This term in PE we are doing Hockey and Basketball with Respect and Tolerance.

Art

In Art we are learning how to arrange shapes, colours and materials to create a composition.

Homework

Your child will take their reading book home (Monday - Thursday) along with a note of pages to read aloud to an adult each night.

Other Curricular Areas

ICT - We will build our typing skills by exploring the keyboard, learning to save and open our work files. We will access and use information to extend our digital literacy skills and discuss ways to be safe online.

Health and Wellbeing - Create a Class Charter. Daily Emotional Check in, discussing emotions and how to manage them.

RME - Learn about Judaism - beliefs, buildings, stories and celebrations.

Mathematics

- Number - order and place value.
