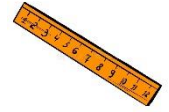


# Optional Family Learning Grid

<b>Numeracy</b>	<b>Junk Model Challenge</b> Can you build a junk model castle? Use your knowledge of common features of a castle to help you. Think about the 3D shapes you have used in the process.	<b>Comparing and Measure</b> Research some famous castles and put them in order of height starting from smallest to largest. Which one is your favourite?
<b>Other</b>	<b>Research</b> Can you find out about a famous person from history who lived in a castle? Write down some facts about them.	<b>Library Visit</b> Why not visit the Shetland Library and see if you can find any fiction or nonfiction books about castles for you to read at home.
