English

Reading - Developing our fluency and accuracy when reading aloud as well as focusing on reading for enjoyment.

Vocabulary/Spelling - Learn new spelling patterns using a variety of strategies.

Grammar/Punctuation - Revise direct speech, pronouns and plurals.

Writing - Most of our writing will be topical.

Listening and talking - This will be encouraged in all areas of the curriculum. In particular listening and talking in group discussions and how we can improve our skills.
