

Term 3 Curriculum Overview

Primary 7 - 2025-26

Literacy

- **Reading** - Pupils will continue to read a variety of books in class and at home. This term we will focus on novels.
- **Writing** - most of our writing will be topical and we will explore dialogue in fiction, writing a 1-sided and a 2-sided argument.
- **Spelling** - We will continue with phonics/spelling focusing on homophones, word endings, unstressed vowel sounds and commonly misspelt words.
- **Listening and Talking** - will be embedded through topic work, pupils will deliver topic talks.

- **Digital Literacies** - We will continue to build on skills in coding and Microbits through our climate topic.
- **Health Topic** - our health, this term, will continue to focus substances and their effect on the body.
- **RME and Citizenship** - We will continue to learn about Judaism in addition to exploring Easter traditions.
- **Climate** - We will be learning about Scotland's natural resources, including hydrocarbons and renewables. We will investigate climate change and will be entering the Climate Smarter Challenge.
