Primary 7

English

- Reading we will focus on finding key information from texts to answer a range of questions. We would encourage pupils to read a range of texts at home to develop fluency and expression. Our class novel, this term, is Holes.
- Writing most of our writing will be topical and will involve poetry, character description and self-refection
- Listening and talking will be embedded through topic work
