

# Term 4 Curriculum Overview

Primary 7 - 2025 - 26

## Literacy

- **Reading and Comprehension** - We will continue to read a variety of different novels.
- **Writing** - most of our writing will be topical and will include how to write a 2-sided argument, creating fictional stories and writing imaginative diary entries.
- **Spelling** - Spelling patterns will continue to be taught on a weekly basis, time will be spent revising common tricky spellings and prior concepts.
- **Listening and Talking** - will be embedded through topic work. Pupils will continue to develop group discussion and presentation skills.

## Music

We will be learning about music from different cultures, focusing on two songs from West Africa & Tanzania. We will also be preparing musical performances for our leaver's assembly.

## Art

In Art we are developing our ability to observe an object and capture the various angles and details accurately. We are also learning to design our own cartoon character by evaluating sketches, selecting the most appropriate one and producing a prototype using clay.

## Numeracy

- **Revision of the four operations** - multiplication, division, addition and subtraction. With a focus on problem solving.
- **Fractions, Decimals and Percentages** - simplifying fractions, finding a fraction and percentage of a quantity, creating equivalent fractions.
- **Beyond Number** - Probability, time, data handling, measurement and co-ordinates.

## Language - French/German

- French will be revised throughout term 4
- German - pupils will be introduced to German greetings, numbers, family members, colours, foods, and calendar.
