Scalloway Chairperson's Report 2023

It has been great to see the return of face to face Parent Council meetings over the last year. The Parent Council is fortunate to receive an update from the Head Teacher at every meeting that highlights what is happening in the school that term. This has led to discussions on a wide range of topics over the year including: Staffing, School Improvement Plan, Team Improvement Visit, Pupil Equity Funding, Education Reform, Pupil Transitions into P1 and S1, School Meals, School Trips, Homework, UNCRC, development of the Indoor/Outdoor area, the revamp of the school Vision, Values and Aims and much more.

It has been wonderful to see so many parents interested in joining the parent council over the last year and have such a high uptake of parent members. At the AGM last year we approved a change to the constitution to increase the maximum number of parent members to 25.

It has been brilliant to see the return of in school events. The school held a very successful Fish and Chip night in September 2022 which raised over £2,600 towards school funds. Families were invited into the school in March for a Learning Walk where pupils took their family members on a tour of the school, a visit to their classroom and a look at some of their class work.

Parent members have served tea/coffee and homebakes at events in the school this year, including the Fish and Chip night, Parents Evening and the Learning Walk event. We hope to be able to contribute towards more social events over the coming year.

This year Diana and I have attended the Parent Council Bi-Annual meetings where we discuss issues affecting education in all of Shetland schools and we get an opportunity to hear about good practice from other chairs and vice-chairs. Topics this year have included the Education Reform consultation, Xpressions pilot, Digital Learning, Social Security Scotland and information on the increase of Vaping.

I would like to thank my fellow Parent Council members who have devoted their time, enthusiasm, and commitment to supporting the school and Parent Council during the last year, and in particular Diana our vice-chair for her help and support. I would also like to thank our Clerk; Dawn Ratter for her minute taking and organisational support. And once again I would like to thank Morag and all her staff for all that they do for our bairns.
