Numeracy

- ⊗ Do you know the age (numbers) of everyone in your house? Who is the youngest? Who is the oldest? You could take a picture of you all in order of age?
- ⊗ Can you spot your number (age) when you are out and about? It could be a house number, car registration..
- ⊗ Can you make a pattern using resources from inside or out.



Colours - Focus on a

different colour a week: this week is red

Have a hunt in house and see what different things you can find that are red. How many things can you draw with a red crayon/pen? Can you find red things outside too? What emotion does red make you feel? Can you speak about that emotion or draw it?
