<ul style="list-style-type: none"><u>Cody Rhodes reads Gigantic CBeebies Bedtime Story - YouTube</u> <p>Listen to the story of 'Gigantic'.</p> <p>Can you draw a picture of the main characters in the story?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">If you met them what would you ask them?Have a discussion with your child about their characters.	<p>Can you find some items in your house that are 'gigantic' and others that are small?</p> <p>Choose 5 items and order them by size.</p> <p>You can ask your child simple comparison questions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Which is smaller/larger?Are these the same or different?I think this one is smaller am I right?	<p>Before going outside to play, can you tell your grown up what you need to wear outdoors on a snow day?
