Music - We will continue to develop our knowledge and understanding of pulse, rhythm and pitch through nursery rhymes, poems, action games and singing games. We will work on showing pitch with hand movements and pictorial representations. We will improvise pulse actions for a range of songs and rhymes and reinforce our understanding of the differences between pulse and rhythm, rhyme and song as well as all the different ways that we can use our voices (whispering, singing, talking, shouting, and our thinking voice which relates to inner hearing).

Primary 1 enjoy 1-2 dedicated outdoor learning sessions a week in the local Sound area. This term we will be exploring the local beaches, Seafield Area and shopping at Tesco as part of our Farm to Fork Learning.

Literacy

1. Phonics - Revising sets of sounds, diagraphs and blending sounds to read and write words.
2. Reading - Fostering a love of stories through drawing club, story time and reading groups.
3. Reading & Writing - Becoming familiar with common words such as 'the, and, when, where, was, in, to' etc
4. Writing - Letter and number formation, using a tri grip pencil hold, adopting a supportive posture for writing. Writing through our play provision opportunities.
5. Writing - Annotating our drawings, writing imaginative pieces, functional, exploring poetry and non-fiction writing.
6. Listening and Talking - Turn taking skills, active listening, responding and asking questions. Sharing our experiences and achievements. Communicating verbally and non-verbally or using images to support conversations.

Home Learning
