<p><u>Circles and Squares Groups.</u> Adding and taking away in tens. With an adult or sibling, get them to choose any number between 0 and 100. Can you count up to 100 in 10s from that number? Example 24, 34, 44, 54, 64, 74, 84, 94</p> <p>Remember not to count up in 10 ones but just to add one ten!</p> <p>Can you also count back in 10s? Example: 97, 87, 77, 67, 57, 47, 37, 27, 17, 7</p> <p><u>Triangles Group - Missing Numbers</u> Get an adult to write down a sequence of 4 or 5 numbers but with 1 number missing. Example: 11, 12, ?, 14, 15</p> <p>What number is missing? Can be ascending or descending. Example 2: 25, 24, 23, 22, ?</p> <p>Can use visual number line if needed, try without first though.</p>	<p>Can you read and write these common words? You could choose to do this on paper or outside in the snow!</p> <p>I the me said you my</p>  <p>Let's continue our work on verbs. Remember a verb is a doing word. Examples: skating, listening, looking.</p> <p>Look at a different busy winter scene below the grid. How many verbs can you find today? Example holding an umbrella. Choose 3 to write in a sentence. Example: The girl is holding a pink umbrella.</p>	 <p>Drawing and colouring in can be very relaxing. Can you follow this video, step by step to draw your own snow globe? https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=FeYJAGqmNs4&ab_channel=ArtforKidsHub</p> <p>Remember you can pause the video if you need more time! You can also do it in pencil first and then go over it in pen if you wish.</p>  <p>There are lots of jobs that you could do to help around the house. Why not try asking your adult if they could use some help making dinner?</p>
