Primary 3b

Literacy

- Continue to learn new spelling patterns, common words and tricky words.
- Write consistently using the correct heights and letter formation.
- We will begin to learn the joins for joined up handwriting.
- Develop our comprehension skills.
- Continue to develop our fluency when reading aloud, using the correct pace of reading and ensuring we are loud enough to be heard.
- Learn about a variety of listening and talking skills.

Physical Education

In PE, we will be learning:

- dance focussing on cue recognition
- General Games with a focus on responsibility & leadership
- Skipping with a focus on stamina

Other Curricular Areas

Our topic is Healthy Bodies.

- Learn about the skeleton and major organs.
- Discover the senses we have.
- Become aware of how cleanliness, hygiene and safety can affect health and wellbeing.
- Discover a range of foods and how they contribute to a healthy diet.
- Learn about the correct names for the parts of the body.

Numeracy and Mathematics
