

# Term 3 Curriculum Overview

## 2024-2025 Primary 2B

### English

- **Reading** - We will continue to increase our knowledge of sounds and phonics to help us read with more fluency. We will begin to ask questions to encourage comprehension skills.
- **Writing** - We will be doing writing linked to our fairy tale topic. We will begin to identify the nouns, verbs and pronouns in our writing.
- **Listening and talking** - We will be respectfully listening to others and working on talking to the class as a whole through individual talk presentations.
- **Handwriting** - Continue to ensure we have correct letter formation and begin to look at comparing the size and position of letters.
- **Spelling** - We will continue to revise sounds and learn new sounds to improve our understanding of spelling rules.
- Revise rhyme with rhyming books and linked activities.

### Science, Social Studies and ICT

- Our school values this term are inclusion and respect.
- Our topic this term is Fairy Tales. We will create and identify different types of housing and check how they meet the needs of our fairyland characters. We will suggest appropriate materials to design and construct models. We will explore and experiment with sketching, manually or digitally
