

Newsletter October 2021 - Welcome to Term 2

New Footpath markings in Tingwall Carpark

The Roads department of the Council has been busy white lining the carpark, to create a footpath for the pupils who live at the Gaet-A-Gott, Stura, Gorsten area, to walk to school safely. Please take care not to park over the white lines if you are dropping bairns off for School/Nursery. Thanks to members of the Parent Council and Councillor Moraig Lyall, for their support in helping to make this happen.

Car Park - a reminder of our safety rules:

Nursery parents please try to park at the top end of the car park, nearest the Nursery entrance – avoid the white lines of the new footpath.

All parents:

The school buses will be dropping of pupils in front of the hall between 8:40 am and 8:50 am, so please leave this area clear.

If collecting your child between 2:45 pm and 3:00 pm, please follow the guidelines below:

- 1 You must be parked before the children come out of school at 2.55-3.00 pm. Drive SLOWLY everywhere in the car park, both before and after the school day.
- 2 Please leave the area in front of the hall free for the big Robinson's bus to park. It will leave just after 3 pm.
- 3 Please do not leave the carpark until all children are safely in vehicles.
- 4 If someone else is collecting your child you must tell them our car park rules.

All vehicle drivers are asked to drive slowly, be vigilant and be courteous to pedestrians.

Please also watch out for **cyclists** who may be leaving school from the front driveway and joining the main road.

<u>Covid Guidelines</u> - A reminder of the mitigations in place in school to help keep your child safe:

the use of hand sanitisers and virucidal wipes;
daily hand sanitisation for all children on arrival;
enhanced daily cleaning and further cleaning undertaken daily at the end of each pupil day; and
careful monitoring to ensure the appropriate level of ventilation and adequate air flow throughout buildings with CO2 monitors deployed, monitoring the level of CO2, and temperature in classrooms
\square the one setting per day principle for itinerant and shared school and early learning and childcare staff;
pupil travel out of school for essential curriculum activity/purposes only;
□ the suspension of face-to-face parents' evenings;
🛮 staff undertake regular Asymptomatic lateral flow tests
adults staying 2m apart and wearing masks
parents/carers continuing to avoid contact with other parents, children and young
people at the school entrance, on the way to school, and after school as well as wearing
face coverings on school grounds;

The pupils will remain in their separate Nursery, P1-3 and P4-7 'Bubbles' for the first couple of weeks, to be reviewed in light of up-to-date local guidelines.

Thank you to those parents who are continuing to encourage their children to wear facemasks on school transport.

Anyone with Covid symptoms such as a new or persistent cough, fever or a change in or loss of taste or smell, need to immediately self-isolate with their household and book a PCR test.

If, through routine testing, you have a positive lateral flow test result, even though you have no symptoms you must do the same as if you have – that is to self-isolate with your household and arrange a PCR test.

To book a PCR test, visit https://www.shb.scot.nhs.uk/ and click on the box which reads 'Self-referral for Covid test', if you have symptoms.
