Covid-19 Reminders

Information from Public Health highlights that it can take up to 14 days from the date of exposure to Covid, for someone to test positive, so please remain vigilant to the three main symptoms: new or persistent cough, fever or a change in or loss of taste or smell (even one of these symptoms could be a sign). However, please also be aware that some people, who have tested positive, have not experienced any of the main symptoms,

but have had sore throats, headaches and heavy colds. No one should come to school or nursery if at all unwell, even with mild symptoms.

A reminder of the normal mitigations in place in school to help keep your child safe:

🛮 the use of hand sanitisers and virucidal wipes;
🛮 daily hand sanitisation for all children on arrival;
$\hfill \Box$ enhanced daily cleaning and further cleaning undertaken daily at the end of each pupil day; and
careful monitoring to ensure the appropriate level of ventilation and adequate air flow throughout buildings with CO2 monitors deployed, monitoring the level of CO2, and temperature in classrooms
$\hfill\square$ the one setting per day principle for itinerant and shared school and early learning and childcare staff;
Dupil travel out of school for essential curriculum activity/purposes only;
🛘 pupils wearing face masks on school transport
🛮 the suspension of face-to-face parents' evenings;
🛮 staff undertake daily Asymptomatic lateral flow tests
🛮 adults staying 2m apart and wearing masks
parents/carers continuing to avoid contact with other parents, children and young people at the school entrance, on the way to school, and after school, as well as wearing
face coverings on school grounds;

Anyone with Covid symptoms needs to immediately self-isolate with their household and book a PCR test.

If, through routine testing, you have a positive lateral flow test result, even though you have no symptoms, you must also self-isolate with your household and arrange a PCR test.
