Meningitis and septicaemia Know the symptoms

Red symptoms are more specific to meningitis and septicaemia and less common in milder illnesses. Not everyone gets all these symptoms.

MENINGITIS

Fever and/or vomiting

Severe headache

Rash (not all cases)

Stiff neck*

Dislike of bright lights*

Very sleepy/vacant/ difficult to wake

Confused/delirious

Seizures (fits)

SEPTICAEMIA

Fever and/or vomiting

Limb/joint/muscle pain

Cold hands and feet/ shivering

Pale or mottled skin

Breathing fast/ breathless

Rash (not all cases)

Very sleepy/vacant/ difficult to wake

Confused/delirious

*Less common in babies and toddlers
