About Our Parent Council

In every school in Scotland, the parents, guardians or carers of children in the school are collectively known as the school's 'Parent Forum'. Under the Scottish Schools (Parental Involvement) Act 2006, each Parent Forum has the right to set up a Parent Council, made of parent members and representatives from the school and the local community. The role of parent councils is to:

- Support the school in its work with pupils;
- Represent the views of parents and carers;
- Encourage links between the school, parents and carers, pupils, pre-school groups and the wider community.

The Whiteness School Parent Council has up to eight parent members; along with two co-opted members; a teacher and the three local councillors. The Head Teacher also attends meetings. We are involved in a number of activities including fundraising, running the crèche at Parents' Meetings, consulting with parents and helping at the School Sale.

Contact us!

We are keen for parents to contact us if they have any issues, concerns or ideas that they would like us to raise with the school or with Children's Services. We do try to have parent members with children in each of the school years, including Early Years, so that hopefully means that all parents will know of someone on the Parent Council.

We can only know about problems if you tell us about them!

You can speak confidentially to Parent Council members, and we will raise issues anonymously on your behalf: we would not identify you or your child unless you wanted that.

(Please note though that we cannot become involved in concerns relating specifically to individual children).
