Dear Parent/Carer

Return to School August 2020

We are very much looking forward to welcoming back all pupils and families, with a particularly warm welcome to all our new Primary 1 pupils. We are aware that school will look and feel different for us all, but as always, our priority will be to support the health and wellbeing of all pupils, parents/ carers and staff.

You will be aware that Scottish Government have now agreed on a full time return for all pupils by Tuesday 18th August. The full document can be accessed via the following link:

In line with the advice above and letter of 3 August from Tony McDaid, Executive Director Education Resources, South Lanarkshire Council and further to my email (4th August) I write to advise you of our detailed plans for a managed return as per below: Please also find attached with this communication an updated Q&A. This has been revised in light of the recent government guidance and survey responses from our parents/carers.

Date	Managed Return Arrangements
Tuesday 11 August	Inset Day, school closed to all pupils
Wednesday 12 August	All P1 pupils from P1 and P1/2 only (Staggered times previously issued still apply for first day only)
Thursday 13 August	P1, P1/2, P2, P3 and P3/4 only (All P1 and P2 pupils 8.50am-9.00am)
Friday 14 August	P4/5, P5, P5/6, P6/7, P7 only.
Monday 17 Augu	All pupils from Primary 1-7

The school has a capacity for approximately 480 pupils, however our pupil role for this session is 254. Taking this into consideration we have decided not to stagger the start and finish times for our pupils. However, P1 and P2 pupils can be dropped off at the infant door between 8.50am and 9.00am where they will be greeted by staff and supported to settle into their class. To comply with social distancing requirements please only enter the playground if it is necessary to support your child's needs. When

General advice

- ✓ All children will be required to wash or sanitise their hands on entry to the school building and to classes.
- ✓ There remains the need for 2m social distancing around the school perimeter at all times for parents/carers and any other visiting adults. Where this is difficult, our advice would be to wear a face covering where possible.
- ✓ We are required to keep the number of visitors to the school to a minimum, in accordance with national guidance. Any contact with the school should be made by telephone or email to the office in the first instance. Please do not approach class teachers or support staff in the playground.
