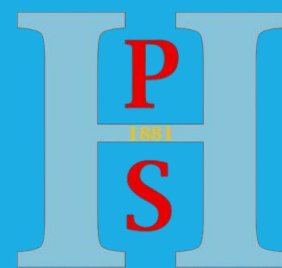

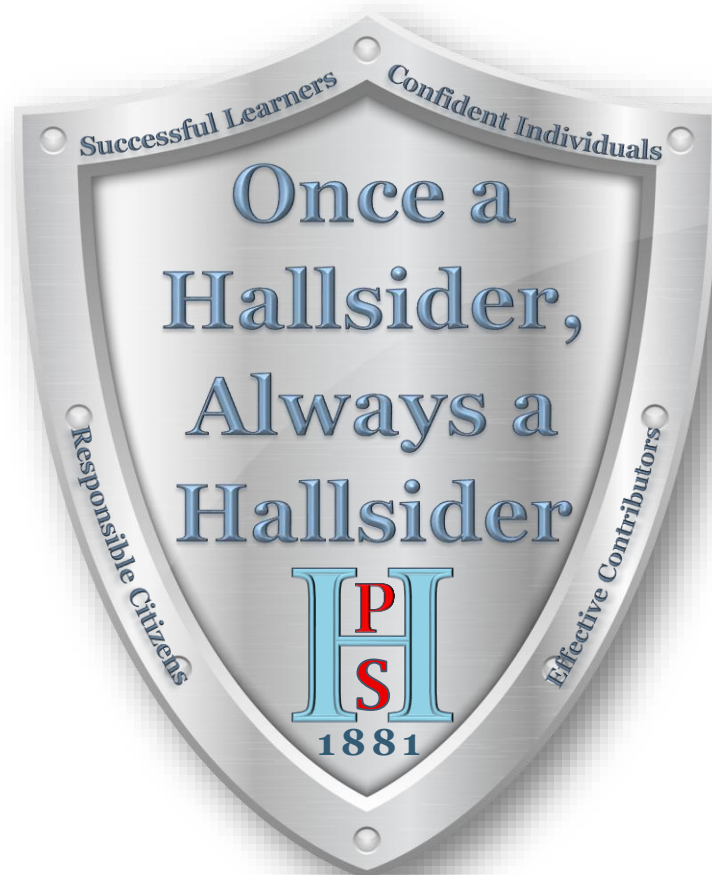


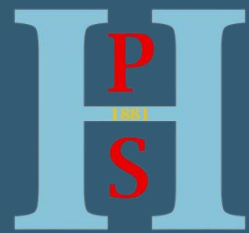

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# ABOUT OUR SCHOOL

- Hallside Primary School is a non-denominational school situated to the east of Cambuslang. The school serves a catchment area comprising private and local authority housing and covers the village of Hallside, almost all of Drumsagard village, some parts of Halfway and Westburn villages. The school is part of the Cathkin Learning Community. This session we have a current roll of 333 children over 12 classes. Data highlights an equity profile of 18% and 5% of learners have English as an additional language.

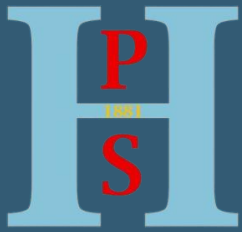
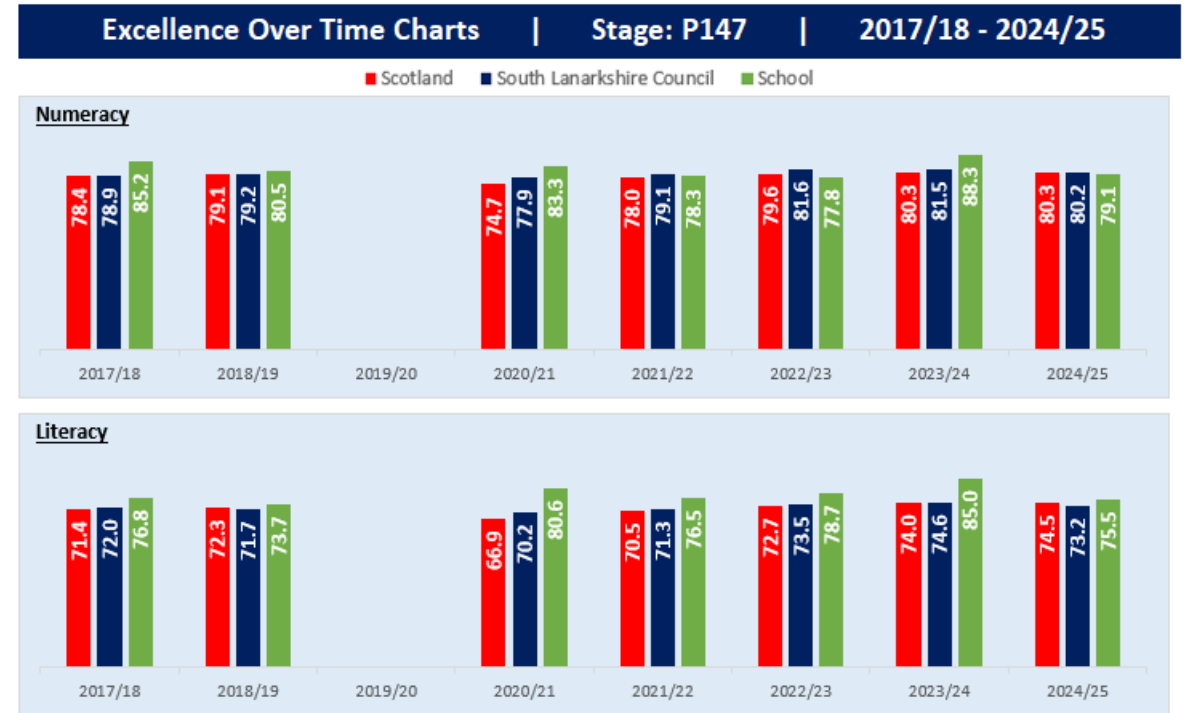


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# Attainment

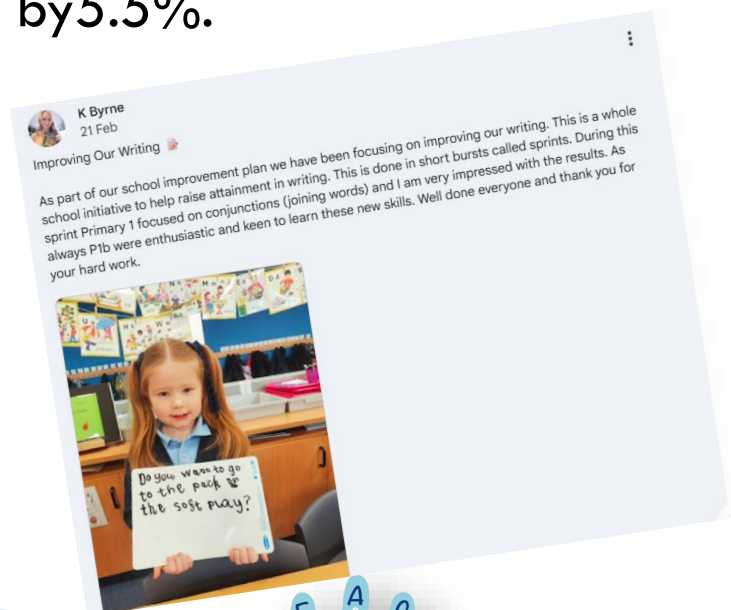

# IMPROVING OUR WRITING

The school community worked together to further 'Improve Writing' across all classes. Pupil survey results evidence increased enjoyment in writing, staff survey results demonstrate increased confidence in the teaching of writing and overall attainment in writing increased across P1-P7 classes from previous session by 5.5%.

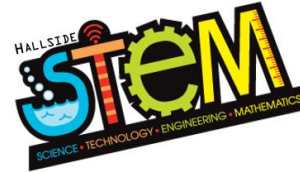
