I would like to reassure you that all facilities within our building will have been thoroughly cleaned in compliance with the COVID-19 Health Protection Scotland Guidelines for Non-Healthcare Settings. This includes all touch points and surfaces before and after use. Could I also ask that parents refrain from gathering outside the main entrance to the school so that social distancing can be observed? If your child is unable to attend the visit for whatever reason then please do not worry.
