How?

Priority 2

How?

- Whole school Glasgow Wellbeing Assessments completed
- Classroom environment set up with pupil collaboration and Inclusive Classroom
- Staff Emotion Works training to further embed throughout school
- Partnership with Healthy Valleys
 with local families worker for school
 workshops and promoting drop-in
 sessions.

Priority 3

Embedding Skills Framework

How?

- Staff training linking skills to Enquiry Based Learning and decide how it can be used in each class
- Create an action plan and work on this throughout Terms 1-3
- Staff and pupil moderation across the learning community

Outcome

- Literacy and learning through Enquiry Based learning will provide children with opportunities to improve their writing skills
- Improved reading and writing attainment in targeted children

Outcome

- Improvement in whole school attendance
- Most learners show consistent high levels of engagement within Literacy and Numeracy
- Enhanced Staged intervention process
- · Reduced incidents of distressed behaviour
- Improvement of classroom ethos, pupil motivation and learners skills

Outcome

- Develop a shared understanding and language of skills development using SLC Framework
- Children will use skills language to evaluate and set personal targets
- Parents will have an awareness of skills framework and how it is used in school
