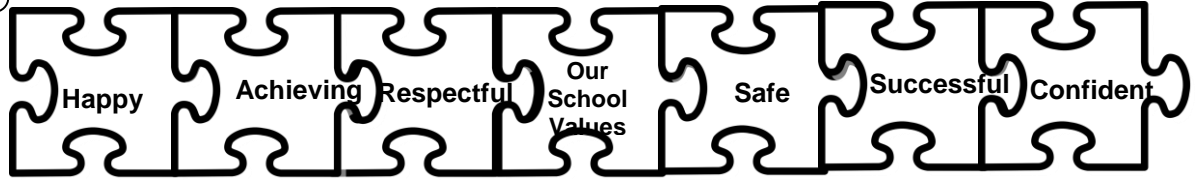


Carmichael Primary School Vision
