Transition

Our P7 pupils will be heading to Lanark Grammar School for their 2 day visit on Wednesday and Thursday of this week. Children are to make their own way to and from the Grammar on these days. They should arrive at the school by 9:20am – I will be waiting in the street area to greet them. They will be put into their classes to begin with then will follow their timetable until 2.30pm which will be the end of the school day for them. Parents should collect their children from the school at this time. I would recommend car sharing if possible as it is always difficult to park and very busy around the school throughout the day. Children are then free to go home – they should not return to Braehead Primary. This will be the arrangement once again on Thursday. A letter was issued to all P7 pupils from Mrs Wilson outlining information regarding the school show and how to purchase a house badge on the two day visits; should you require this information again please let me know.

I am sure the children are very excited about this next step on their journey, we wish them all the very best.

Primary 1 Transition

The last of our transition visits for our new Primary 1 children will be on Tuesday of this week from 1:15pm-2:45pm. All children have settled very well on the last two visits – we very much look forward to them joining us permanently in August.

Having an additional class in the school hall four mornings per week makes a real difference to our class sizes and has been very successful over the last two sessions.

Miss Kennedy is also moving on to pastures new at the end of this session. She has decided to take some time to travel with her family across America. This is a very exciting opportunity

and we wish her all the very best. Miss Kennedy has been a member of staff at Braehead for 11 years and will be greatly missed by our school community.

I am delighted that Mrs Wallace has agreed to increase her hours to work 4 days per week on return to school in August, this fills the vacancy Miss Kennedy leaves and provides stability and continuity for our children.

As you will see each class will have a maximum of 3 teacher across the week. This is very common in all primary schools and is very good, especially in the senior stages in preparing children for their transition to secondary school where they will meet eight teachers per day.

All of this information is subject to change over the summer should our new teacher be withdrawn for any reason, we hope this is not the case and look forward to a settled session for all children at Braehead.

Previously Loved Uniform

As we try to look at ways in which we can reduce the cost of the school day I would encourage parents to recycle any previously loved uniforms for others to use. If your child has outgrown any of the uniform and you feel it is in good condition please return it to the school where we will set it up for recycling. Hopefully this will allow us to set up a table on morning of Friday 28 June for parents to come along and help themselves to whatever they feel will be of use. Like the Christmas Jumper swap the success of this venture very much depends on people using the service — it would be great if this was something we could establish to run year on year in the school.

Free School Meals/Clothing Grants

If you are in receipt of housing benefit and/or council tax reduction from SLC there is no need to apply for free school meals online – the information held by the council will be used to automatically award free school meals to pupils in P4-S6 and/or clothing grants to eligible families of P1-S6 children. For further information regarding eligibility please search either free school meals of clothing grants on SLC website.
