Swimming Lessons

Our block of swimming lessons for Primaries 5-7 begins on the first week back (Friday 16 August) and will be on Friday afternoons for 12 weeks plus an additional date for the 'Save a Life' session – all dates will be supplied in the new session. The school will subsidise the cost of the lessons themselves (approximately £650) and will contribute to the transport costs, however in order to participate in this we have to ask for a contribution of £3 per week, per child to help with transport costs. This should be paid through Parent Pay – this will be set up in time for August. Please note that transport costs are non-refundable should your child be absent on a swimming day.
