Jointly with Braehead Parent Council, a decision has been made to postpone the Bingo Night planned for Wednesday, we will reschedule this later in the session. When we are in a position to share a new date we will inform you of this. Should this new date be unsuitable, ticket sales will be refunded. Thank you for the tombola donations received and thank you to Mrs Campbell for contacting those local businesses who donated prizes to extend the expiration date of said prizes.
