Dear Parents/Carers.

Test and Protect

South Lanarkshire Council is working in partnership with North Lanarkshire Council and NHS Lanarkshire to help protect all members of our school community. As detailed in the flow chart issued to all families last week, should your child or a member of your household develop any of the COVID-19 symptoms, please DO NOT send them to school.

We are aware that now all children are back in the school environment common colds are inevitable. However, if your child is coughing continuously in class, complaining of a cough or has a high temperature we are duty bound, as these are COVID-19 symptoms, to advise you to have your child tested before returning to school. If this is the case the symptomatic child and any sibling(s) should not attend school until a negative result has been received. Fortunately, the wait time from testing to results is quick and normally within 24 hours.

If you are in any doubt please follow the flow chart issued last week.

Thank you to those parents who have accessed the online homework and home/school diary. We hope you find this a useful form of communication between home and school. If you are experiencing difficulties accessing glow please contact me at school, I am more than happy to try to help sort out any issues.
