Dear Parents/Carers,

It is a pleasure to see the children back in school today after their holiday week. I hope you were all able to enjoy some time together despite the current restrictions. Newsletters now feel like they are all things COVID-19 related, there seems to be no escape however I do feel it is important to communicate any updates as they happen.

Ventilation in Classrooms

Windows, doors and air vents must be open throughout the school day to help mitigate the spread of infection. With the change in weather the children are complaining of the cold and while we await further guidance on requirements during the winter we must still continue to provide this level of ventilation. If you child wishes to wear additional layers, an extra jumper etc. then please feel free to do this – do not worry about uniform at this time. The children feeling warm enough is far more important at this time. This is also the case with staff who may be less formal in the coming weeks to account for the change in temperature.

Lockerbie Manor

The guidance continues to advise against residential visits with school children and I am sure you will agree with this at this time. We still have our booking for 29-31 March 2021 and will continue to liaise with Lockerbie Manor on receipt of further guidance from SLC.

Flu Immunisation

All children who have given consent will receive their flu immunisation on Thursday 29 October in the school.
