

Children should come to school on that day wearing their party clothes or casual clothes whatever the preference is, rather than going home to change. #### **Indoor Shoes**

It has been brought to my attention that there are concerns over children sitting in class with wet feet, this is not something we are aware of but in order to prevent this you are very welcome to send your child to school with indoor shoes to change from wellies/boots if you wish however these indoor shoes must be kept in your child's bag as we must leave all surfaces clear for enhanced cleaning measures which have to take precedence at this time.

With so much time being spent on additional handwashing and sanitising it has been beneficial not to be changing shoes before/after every break as this, over the course of a day, particularly in P1-3 can take up a further 15 minutes of teaching and learning time but we absolutely do not want children to feel wet and uncomfortable. I will leave this decision up to individual parents but please note there is no problem in children changing shoes if you wish.
