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Arrangements on Arrival

In August we stated clearly that children should arrive in school no earlier than 8:45am as the playground is not staffed prior to then and support staff are not available to support children with sanitising and entry to school. Over the last two weeks in particular children have been arriving earlier and earlier in the mornings, sometimes as early as 8:35am.

Moving forward when children arrive in the school playground they will have their hands sanitised by Pamela, our cleaner caretaker, and should leave their bags in the playground until the bell rings at 9am. At that point they will line up on their 'spots' to enter the school. There is no need to come straight into school on arrival to sanitise hands – this will be done in the playground.
